TOURIST GUIDANCE IN THE REPUBLIC OF SLOVENIA

In Slovenia, tourist guide services can **occasionally** be provided without a Slovenian tourist guide exam only by those individuals who are citizens of EU Member States and are already tourist guides in their countries. If tourist guides from an EU Member State **permanently** perform tourist guidance in Slovenia, they are subject to the same conditions as Slovenian citizens (they must pass the tourist guide exam at the Slovenian Chamber of Tourism in Slovene) or have their tourist guide diploma validated at the competent Ministry of Economy, Tourism and Sport.

Individuals **who are citizens of third countries** can only provide tour guide services if they have passed the tour guide exam at the Slovenian Chamber of Tourism in the Slovenian language.

The tourist guide must wear the appropriate tourist guide card in a visible place at all times while performing the profession of tourist guide (the fine for violations ranges from 50 to 150 euros).

Supervision of compliance with legislation in the field of tourist guiding services in Slovenia is performed by the Market Inspectorate of the Republic of Slovenia.
